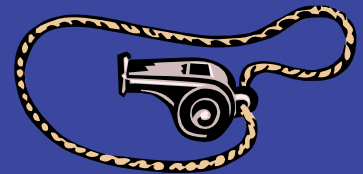
## Graduation Coaches

- Commitment level two: 1 or more hours per week during the school year (approximately 30 weeks)
